Many procedures, such as amniocentesis or chorionic villi testing, are invasive and carry risk of miscarriage. NextGen Jane is building new, safe alternatives that can answer questions about your baby's health without accessing amniotic fluid or capturing cells from the placenta.



We do this by isolating cells from the baby that have naturally made their way from the cervix to the vaginal cavity. By a tampon, we are able to capture some of these cells.

A tampon you might ask, is that safe? Wearing a tampon in pregnancy is safe and less intrusive than intercourse, which of course, is not restricted in pregnancy. When worn for a short time, a tampon can be a great collection device for cells from the vagina. Ours is a light absorbency organic cotton tampon which is only worn for 1 hour.
